


### …After UNISEC 1<sup>st</sup> Global Meeting


- Presentations and sensitization about UNISEC and her activities in Nigeria; since the first Global meeting took place.

- □ The proposal was based on the experiences I gathered from the first global meeting from various countries who participated and shared their view on space research and development especially as regards to small satellite development and human resources development.




The above structure might be a little bit difficult and capital intensive to achieve so I proposed a more flexible way to go about it based on contemporary Nigerian experiences

> There has been a concerted effort between us and CBSS to reach as many high school students within Nsukka and its environs.


