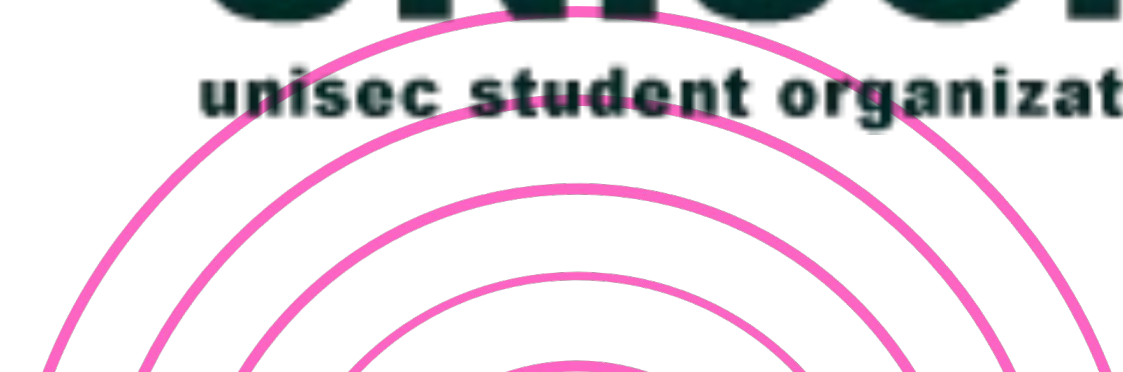

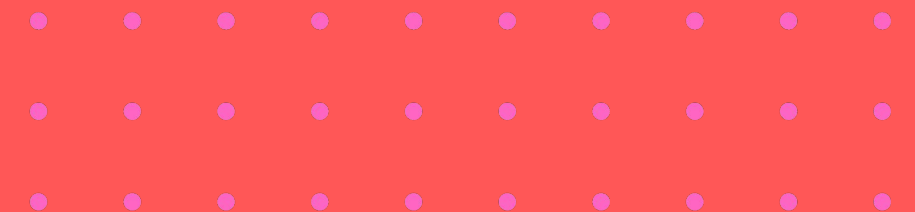

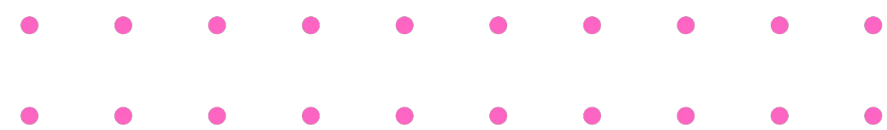

but became inactive due to the pandemic...

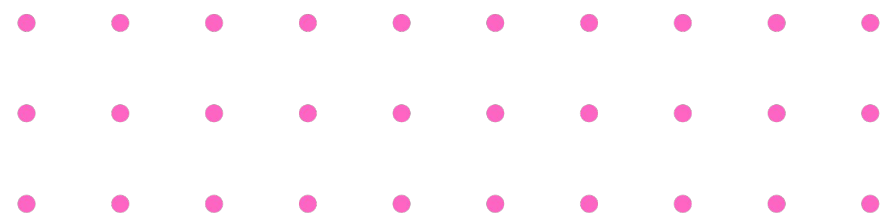
