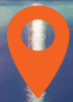

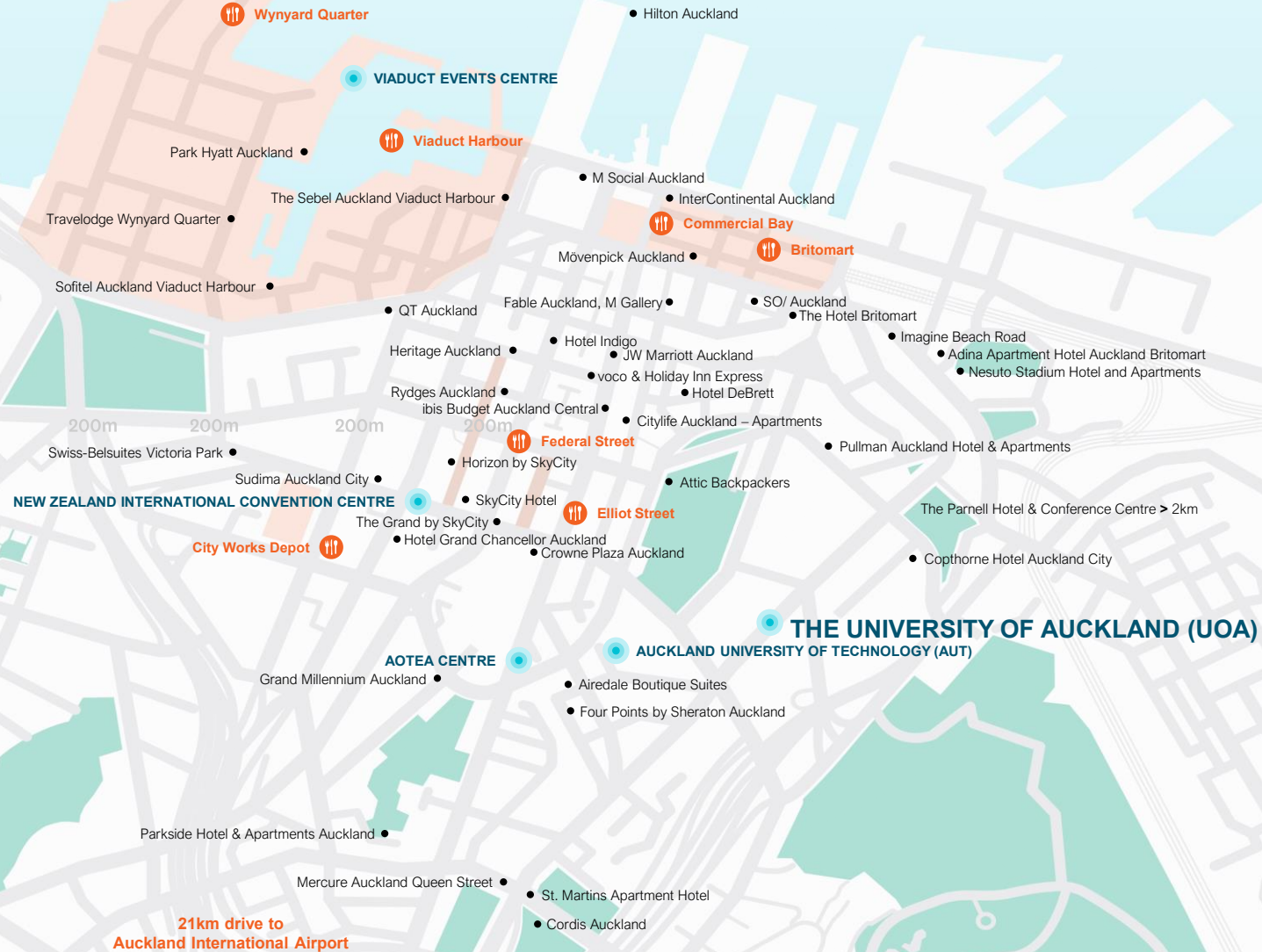

Tāmaki Makaurau Auckland's walkable city centre is packed with a range of accommodation providers and dining precincts within close proximity to conference venues.



The University of Auckland

- The university supports conference activity, as it provides opportunities to disseminate knowledge and connect with international peers.
- Located in the heart of the city, within walking distance of the cultural and entertainment precincts, business headquarters and innovation hubs.
- The Faculty of Engineering is a 12-storey modern and spacious venue with the capacity for large conferences and events. There are two 250 seat-tiered theatres, together with several smaller rooms that are available for parallel sessions.
- All rooms are equipped with state of-the-art, built-in audio/visual equipment.

- Demonstrate programs and services available at the Universities in New Zealand to foster international collaboration.

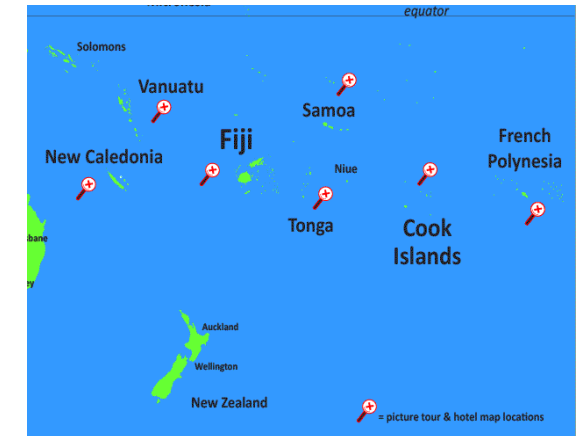

Additional Attendee Costs

- Mid –range accommodation and expenses would be from about NZ\$ 250 to NZ\$ 350 per day. 5 Star is also available for those with larger expense accounts.
- Budget friendly accommodation can be found from about NZ\$ 100 per day. The University of Auckland halls of residence would be available at this time of year also, but have not yet been costed.
- There are plenty of low-cost activities available by bus and on foot in Auckland, from free up to NZ\$ 100.

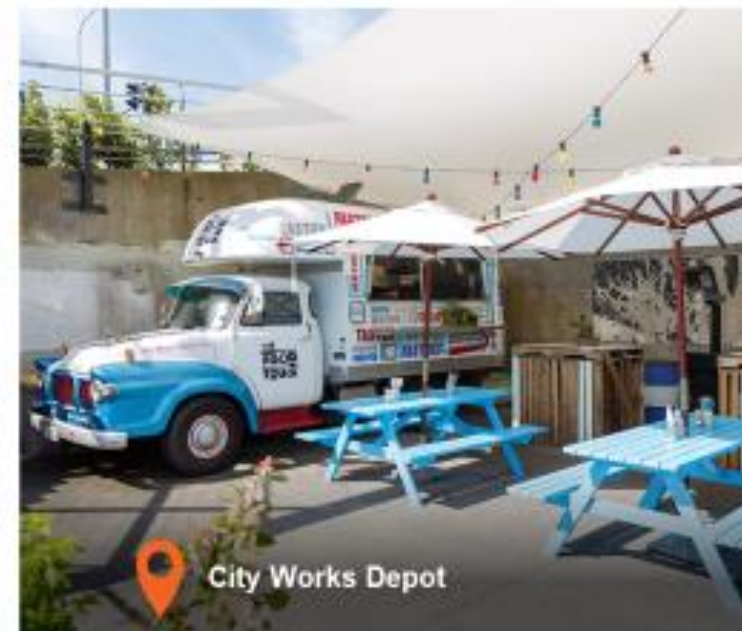
